 - Volunteers are always told of the reason if they are rejected after screening for any study at PAREXEL. If during the screening process any evidence is found of disease that may require further investigation or treatment the volunteer is always advised (in private and in confidence) by a member of the medical staff. In the majority of cases the volunteer is happy for a letter to be written to his/her GP and then takes over the management of the case. If the volunteer does not wish this contact, his/her wishes are respected. Any medical event occurring after dosing is followed up and managed where necessary by consultants on a private basis paid for by PAREXEL and ultimately the sponsor.

This full medical screen is valued by volunteers and regarded by many as a major benefit from participation. We have in the past detected several new cases of diabetes, hypercholesterolaemia, hypertension, leukaemia, hepatitis and HIV (among others) and in this way feel that PAREXEL makes a positive contribution to society.
